* Federal Poverty Level is the set minimum amount of gross income that a family needs for food, clothing, transportation, shelter and other necessities.

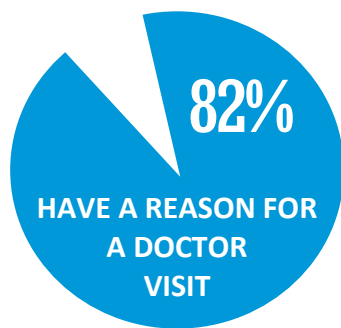

- 1 MEDI-CAL'S EXPANSION TO INCLUDE ALL CHILDREN REGARDLESS OF THEIR IMMIGRATION STATUS:

CHI ASSISTED 1,136 CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES UNDERSTAND THE CHANGES IN THEIR INSURANCE & HELPED THEM STAY INSURED AND AVOID A BREAK IN COVERAGE.
- 2 12,000 CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES WERE ASSISTED LAST YEAR BY CHI STAFF
- 3 3,000 NEW ENROLLMENTS INTO COVERAGE THIS YEAR.
- 4 10,200 CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES RETAINED INSURANCE
- 5 22,000 STUDENTS & THEIR FAMILIES WERE REACHED WITH INFORMATION ABOUT INSURANCE

THE NEED

APPROXIMATELY 10,000 OF NAPA'S RESIDENTS REMAIN UNINSURED

2,880 CHILDREN WOULD LOSE COVERAGE WITHOUT CHI CASE MANAGEMENT.

IN 2020, PROJECTIONS PREDICT THE NUMBER OF SENIOR CITIZENS WILL INCREASE BY 7,802. CHI CAN HELP IMPROVE THE SENIORS' ENROLLMENT, RENEWAL AND UTILIZATION EXPERIENCE.

CHILDREN MISS FEWER DAYS AT SCHOOL WHEN THEY HAVE A REGULAR DOCTOR TO CARE FOR THEM.

PARENTS MISS FEWER DAYS AT WORK WHEN THEIR CHILDREN HAVE A MEDICAL HOME.

FOR EVERY \$1 WE RAISE, WE CAN LEVERAGE OVER \$7 IN HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO OUR MOST VULNERABLE CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES.
